

## **The Killara Cup and Shield: Sunday 13th September 2009**

### **Killara Cup History**

First Played in 1940 as an event open to members of Group 1 clubs. Best scratch score over 36 holes. Changed on 1969 to best individual 18 holes scratch score in conjunction with the Killara Shield.

### **Killara Shield History**

Provided by the Club in 1920 to the NSW Golf Association for foursomes gross stroke competition between two pairs nominated from each group 1 club. It is the oldest event on the NSW Golf Association calendar. It was changed in 1968 to an Eisenhower Cup type event between teams of four from each Group 1 club, aggregate of best three gross scores from each team count. At the same time it was combined with the Killara Cup.

A full field took to the course comprising of 98 players 74 of these players were of a 4 handicap or below and 17 clubs represented for The Killara Shield.

The event was a great success with the following results recorded on the day:

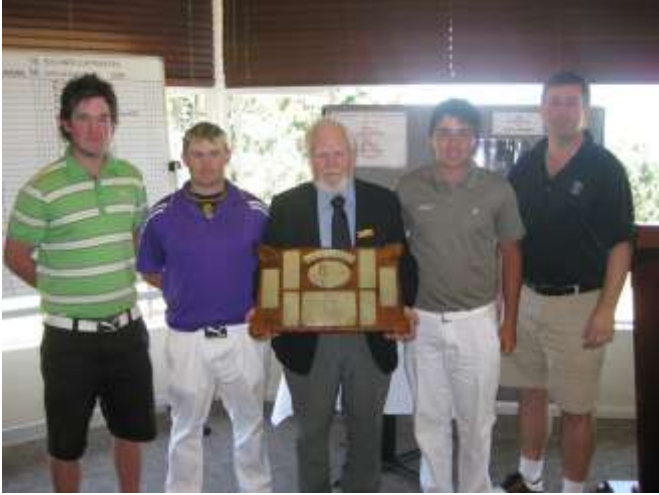
