FIDUCIAN LEGENDS PGA SENIORS CHAMPIONSHIP

Entry terms and conditions

1/. There are two Amateur Events being played concurrently:

Stableford Individual and Four Ball

Thursday 11th and Friday 12th November 2010

Amateurs will be drawn with Professionals and compete over two days for the best Individual Stableford score and a 4 ball best ball Stableford.

Stroke play Scratch Event

Amateurs with Australian Handicaps of 9 or less will also compete in a Stroke play scratch event, with the lowest 10 Amateurs (and ties) at the end of the 36 hole Pro Am being eligible to play in the Championship round on Saturday 13th November. The Senior Amateur Champion and Low Amateur will be determined over 54 holes.

2/. Senior eligibility

To be eligible to participate in the Senior Amateur Championship, participants must have a handicap of 9 or less and have attained 50 years of age on or prior to 11 November 2010.

3/. Handicaps

All amateur participants must have a current Australian Handicap and provide their *GolfLink* number with their application. The maximum allowable handicap for men is 27 and for women is 36. Handicap adjustments will not be made following the first round.

4/. Ballot

In the event that there are more Amateur applicants than there are places available in the field then a ballot will be conducted to determine the successful applicants. The ballot will be conducted at Killara Golf Club by an official of the PGA on Wednesday 13 October 2010 and the names of the successful applicants will be posted on the Tournament page on the Killara Golf Club website www.kgc.com.au

5/. Tee Times

Tee times will be notified prior to event. Please note that the Tee times will be between 0700 and 1300 and that Amateur tee times will be determined by the Professional draw.

As a result it is likely that Amateurs will have an early and a late tee time on successive days.

6/. Trophies

Prizes will be awarded as follows:

Best 18 hole Individual Stableford score: Winner and Runner up Mens and Ladies (Thursday & Friday)

Best 36 hole, 4 Ball best ball Stableford score: Winner Team 2 scores to count

54 hole Stroke play. Low Senior Amateur Trophy. Low Amateur trophy

7/. Dress code

Jeans, cargo-style pants and cord tie/elastic jogging type trousers are not allowed. Only plain white socks or white socks with the Club logo shall be worn with tailored shorts. Shirts, with minimum logo only, must have collars and be tucked in. Caps are not acceptable in the Clubhouse. Metal spikes are not allowed.

8/. Mobile Phones

Mobile phones may not be used in the clubhouse or on the course.

9/. Rules of Golf

The Amateur Events will be conducted in accordance with the Rules of Golf, under the management and control of the Tournament Committee, whose decision on all matters will be final.
